CALL FOR PAPERS GUIDELINES

All technical abstracts submitted will be reviewed by the India Energy Week 2027 Technical Committee. Early submission gives the Committee adequate time to review each abstract.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Abstracts should be up to 500 words and written in English. Submissions in any other language will not be accepted
- Supplementary material such as illustrations, graphs or tables may be included as attachments (maximum 2 attachments, of 2MB each)
- If an abstract could fit more than one category, select the single best fit. Do not submit the same abstract more than once.
- One author may submit multiple abstracts, within the same category or across categories, but the same or a slightly modified abstract must not be submitted more than once
- Wherever applicable, authors submitting on behalf of an organisation must obtain the necessary internal or management clearance before submission. Any clearance issues should be noted at the time of submission.
- Abstracts presented at other conferences are eligible, provided the date and location of the earlier presentation are disclosed. Abstracts submitted to a previous edition of India Energy Week should not be submitted again

GRADING CRITERIA

Abstracts are evaluated by the Technical Committee against four criteria:

1. **Quality:** the accuracy and technical relevance of the data and information presented
2. **Impact:** the demonstrated effect of the work on the industry or organisation, supported by results or case studies
3. **Novelty:** the degree of innovation and originality, including new knowledge, technical results or field experience
4. **Interest and relevance:** how closely the submission speaks to the current state of the energy industry and the India Energy Week audience

ABSTRACT CONTENT

Each abstract should give the Technical Committee enough information to assess it against four elements:

1. **Description:** the scope and nature of the work, including background, rationale, data and technologies used
2. **Applications:** the possible application of the work presented
3. **Results and conclusions:** a summary of results and key conclusions, and how they differ from prior work on the same subject
4. **Technical contribution:** the significance of the work to the technical knowledge base of the energy sector

GUIDELINES FOR ACCEPTED ABSTRACTS

- Authors are notified of acceptance by email.
- Shortlisted authors will be asked to provide details on their abstract.
- Shortlisted authors will be required to submit a full technical paper and a presentation for the Technical Conference
- Presenters to receive complimentary access to the Technical Conference. Co-authors who wish to attend must purchase a pass
- The organiser does not cover travel or accommodation for authors attending or presenting
- In the event that confirmed presenters are unable to present at the conference, they must nominate a substitute to present the abstract. An advance intimation in this regard will be appreciated.
- Acceptance of full paper and presentation is not a confirmation of participation in the main conference. The paper selected for presentation shall be intimated separately.

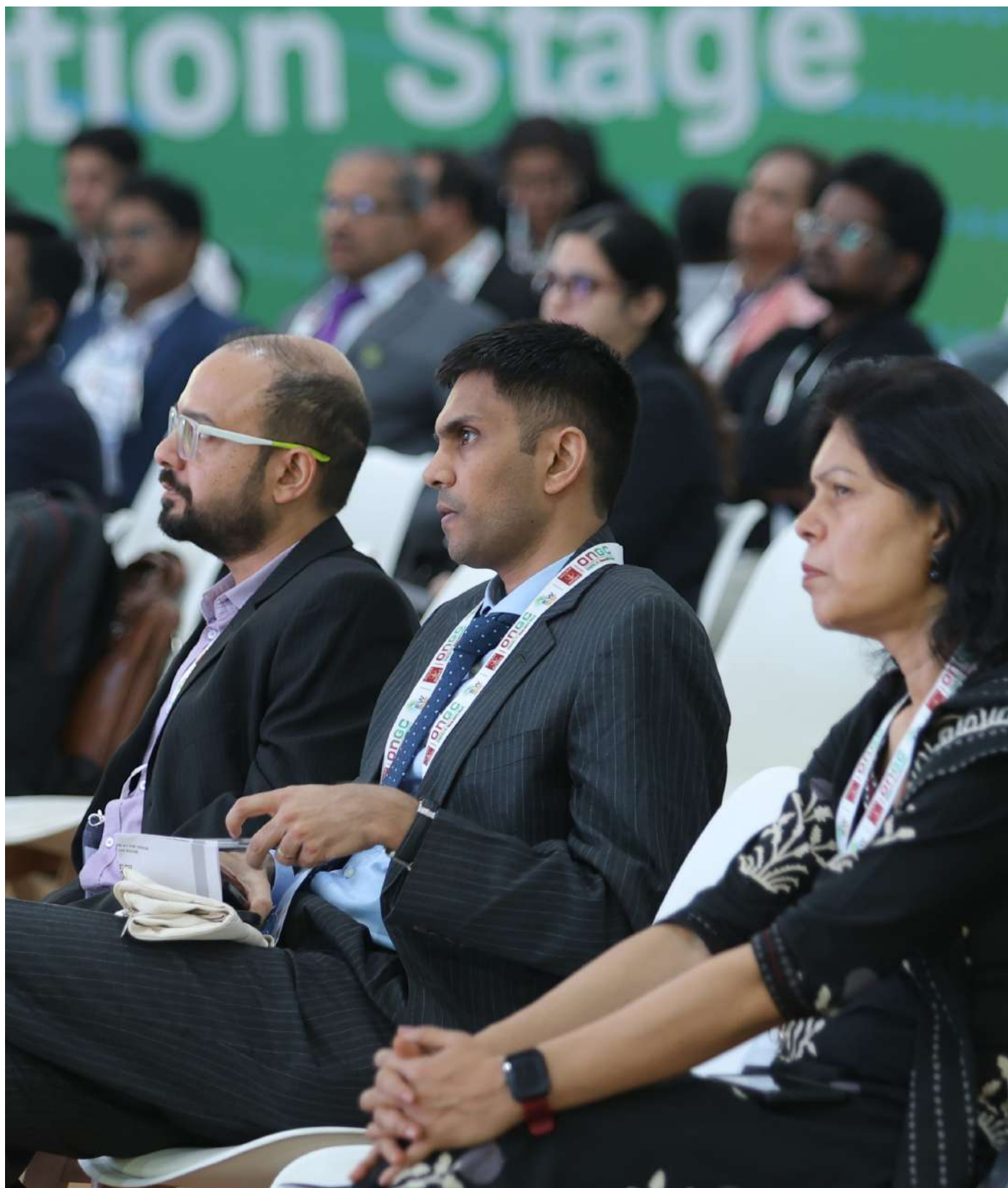
